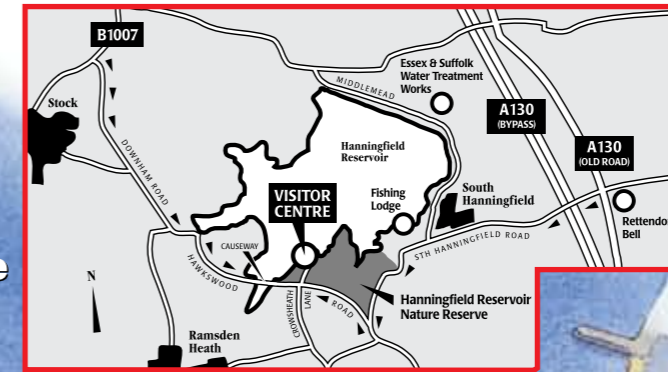


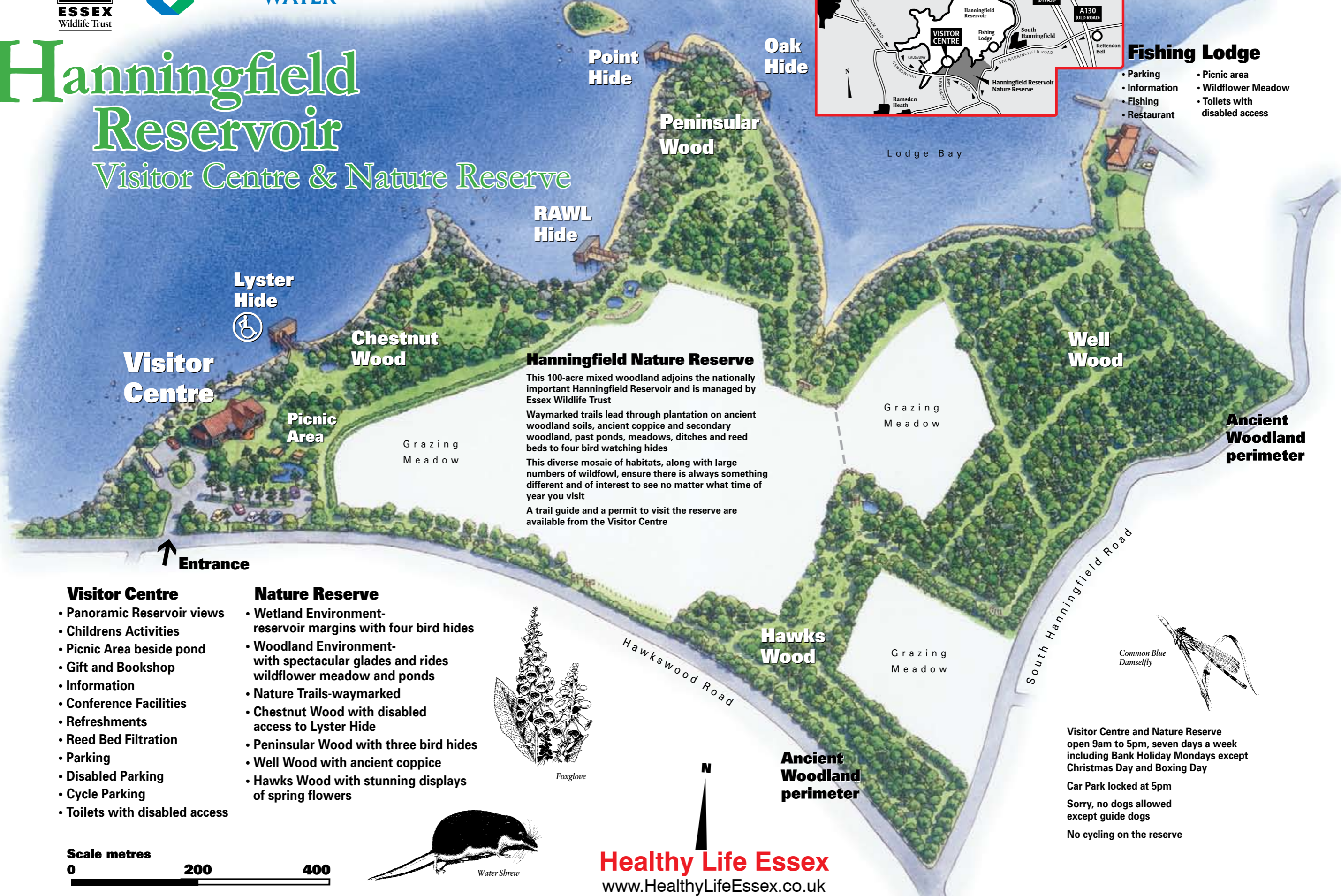

Hanningfield Nature Reserve

This 100-acre mixed woodland adjoins the nationally important Hanningfield Reservoir and is managed by Essex Wildlife Trust

Waymarked trails lead through plantation on ancient woodland soils, ancient coppice and secondary woodland, past ponds, meadows, ditches and reed beds to four bird watching hides

This diverse mosaic of habitats, along with large numbers of wildfowl, ensure there is always something different and of interest to see no matter what time of year you visit

A trail guide and a permit to visit the reserve are available from the Visitor Centre

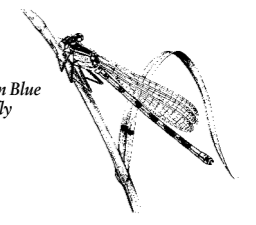
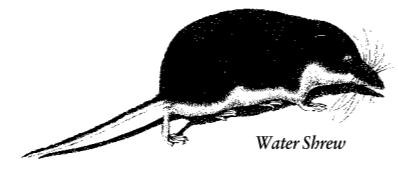
